• Effort/Participation – 15%

All tests will be averaged in as a project grade

Homework – 25% (4 per marking period)

This is a great way to ensure a good grade in this class! Assignments are due Friday, every other week, and are to be done in your sketchbook. Each HW is out of 20 points. Failure to hand in HW on time will affect your grade!
